Solicitation of funds from students and Board employees may be only for charitable, cultural, and civic organizations and shall be subject to the following:

A. Number of Campaigns

Each school may participate in a total of three non-profit campaigns with the stipulations that:

1. Each school may participate in two campaigns without the Director of Schools' approval.
2. Each school may participate in a third campaign if one of merit comes up toward the end of a school year. However, participation in a third campaign must be approved by the Director of Schools.
3. Participation by Board employees in United Way is not included as one of the three campaigns.

B. Solicitation by Cultural and Civic Organizations

1. Cultural and civic solicitation campaigns must have been approved by the Murfreesboro City Council before participation by schools is permitted.
2. A solicitor of funds may not attach a fixed monetary amount to any token given in exchange for a donation. The solicitor may suggest a donation, but must give the token to the donee in exchange for a donation of any amount.

C. Solicitation by Charitable Organizations

1. The staff shall designate these charity drives and schedule them for the schools on a rotating basis.

Notes: This policy has no bearing on PTC/PTO/PTA or the City Schools Foundation activities. PTC/PTO/PTA or the City Schools Foundation solicitations are regulated by each school's PTC/PTO/PTA executive board or the City Schools Foundation Trustees.
