To the extent questions of procedure arise, the ruling of the Chair shall be controlling, unless the Board votes to the contrary. Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised may be used as a reference in making procedural determinations.

VOTING METHOD

When a formal vote is taken on any question brought before the Board, the decision shall be made on the basis of a majority of the membership of the Board, not a majority of the quorum.

Roll call votes will be used at the discretion of the chair or upon the request of any board member. Each member's vote shall be recorded in the minutes on a roll call vote. Upon request, any member's individual vote may be recorded in the minutes. No secret votes shall be used.

CHAIR'S PARTICIPATION

The person chairing a meeting may participate in discussion, make motions, and vote on all issues as any other member without relinquishing the chair.
