

Hobgood Uniform Policy



The road to success.....

The appearance of our students reflects the quality of our school and our performance.

The basic uniform for all Hobgood students is as follows:

1. Solid shirts in **red, navy, or white** are required. Shirts may be short or long sleeve. **Collars are preferred such as polos.** School issued t-shirts will be permissible. NO logos other than the Hobgood logo are allowed. **NO LOW CUT SHIRTS ARE ALLOWED.**
2. Shirts **MUST** be tucked in and worn with a **BELT** if belt loops are present on pants or skirts. **All belts must be black or brown without adornment.** **Kindergarten - First grade may want to wear pants with elastic waists so belts will not be a problem.**
3. Solid colored sweaters/sweatshirts in **red, navy, or white** may be worn over a uniform shirt for warmth.
4. Solid colored short or long sleeve shirts or turtlenecks may be worn underneath uniform shirts for warmth. These must be of the designated school colors and may be mixed and matched. The mix and match cannot be in stripes or bands.
5. Plain bottoms (pants, knee length walking shorts, jumpers or skirts) may be worn in **navy blue, black or khaki (tan)** with belts if appropriate. Pants with cargo pockets or logos are not permissible.
6. Students will not be allowed to wear hoodies, coats, or jackets outside of the classroom.
7. Girls are allowed to wear knee socks and leggings for warmth. They must be a solid color of **red, white, or navy.**
8. **Only tennis shoes or loafers** may be worn at school. Students are encouraged to wear socks. **Flip -flops or Crocs are not allowed**
9. Head coverings such as bandanas, scarves, sweatbands, caps, or hair nets may not be worn during school times or at school functions. Oversized belt buckles or oversized jewelry is not allowed.
10. **Casual dress including jeans may be worn on Fridays.**

Clothing must be the appropriate size.
