1 The general procedure for selecting a new name for a new school shall be as follows:

2

3 The Director of Schools shall appoint a committee composed of a school board member, city
4 council member, community representative(s) and staff member(s). The committee shall be no
5 smaller than 5 members and no larger than 9 members.

7 **Community Input**

8

9 Names for consideration by the committee may be submitted by any citizen, board member or
10 school personnel.

11

12 Proposed names for consideration should be sent to the Director of Schools via email, regular
13 mail or fax.

14

15 The committee shall review and consider all proposed names submitted by the community.

16

17 The school-naming committee shall present a list of not less than two names nor more than four
18 names to the Director of Schools who will present them to the Board.

19

20 The Board shall then make the final selection of the name.

22 **General Guidelines for Name Selection**

23

24 Schools shall not be named for living persons, except for those who have rendered exemplary
25 service to public education as recognized and attested by a vote of the Board.

26

27 Two schools in the system shall not be given the same name and care should be taken to
28 avoid similar names.

29

30 **Schools shall be named for:**

31

32 The area or community in which the school is located, or the street on which the school is
33 located, or a street bordering the school site, if that street is well known in the community,
34 or Presidents, governors or recognized national, state and local leaders who have made an
35 outstanding contribution to the field of education.

36

37 The committee will submit its recommendations about the name of the school with supporting
38 reasons to the Director of Schools.

39

40 **Naming Additional Buildings**

41

42 Facilities other than school shall be given names which describe the facility or the geographic
43 location in the city.

44

45 A single building on a campus with multiple buildings or a specific area on the campus may be
46 named for a living person, provided s/he has made an outstanding contribution to that school.

47

48 The naming of such building or specific area shall not supplant the facility's name.

49

50 If in the judgment of the Board an existing facility should be renamed, the criteria of this policy
51 will apply.

52

53 The Director of Schools shall have the authority to recommend the naming of a portion of a
54 facility, such as a section of a building, a single building on a campus, etc., directly to the Board
55 for approval without the committee process.
